ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR “OHIO CPA PROUD” PROGRAM:

- Have 100% of your organizations’ CPAs as OSCPAs members
- Have a minimum of 25 or more total OSCPAs members within your organization (can be combination of CPAs and related professionals (non-CPAs))
- Be enrolled in OSCPAs organizational billing program – one invoice sent to you for all your members (calculated by individual rates, please see below)

MEMBERSHIP INVESTMENT

- **CPA, senior management role** (partner, shareholder or senior management position) **\$495**
- **CPA, non-senior management role** (CPAs in public accounting, business/industry, government, education and nonprofit) **\$340**
- **CPA, non-resident** (work and live outside of Ohio) **\$160**
- **CPA, retired/part-time** (works fewer than 20 hours/week or 1,000 hours/year) **\$160**
- **Pre-CPA** (on the path to becoming a CPA but not yet completed all the requirements) **\$160**
- **Related professional** (non-CPAs, financial professionals and others who work in a supportive role or in conjunction with CPAs and/or the accounting function) **\$160**
