SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

J. Clarke Price, the retired president and CEO of The Society of CPAs (OSCPA), served OSCPAs and the CPA profession for more than 40 years. TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE CLARKE PRICE ACCOUNTING SCHOLARSHIP AWARD YOU MUST:

- Be attending or enrolled in an NCA or AACSB accredited college or university in Ohio.
- Be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program as part of a plan to obtain 150 semester hours required for the CPA exam.
- Be a U.S. citizen or have a permanent resident visa (green card).
- Be an Ohio resident.
- Have a 3.0 GPA or better.
- Have completed at least 30 semester hours of college credit.
- Be a student affiliate member of The Ohio Society of CPAs. Student affiliate membership is free and can be obtained by completing the membership application at www.ohiocpa.com/membership.
- Non-traditional students and veterans who meet the above eligibility requirements are encouraged to apply.

TO APPLY:

- Submit the following materials to The Ohio CPA Foundation:
 - A completed and signed scholarship application form.
 - Official academic transcripts from all institutions where college credit was obtained. Sealed transcripts can be mailed directly to The Ohio CPA Foundation or enclosed with the application materials.
 - A current resume
- An essay addressing the following topic: Please describe why you want to pursue a career in accounting and how you exemplify leadership, innovation and/or commitment.
- Application materials must be **postmarked by Friday, Nov. 14, 2014** for consideration.

NOTIFICATION

- All applicants will be notified of the results by mail.
- Notification letters will be mailed on Friday, February 27, 2015.
